

Despite global uncertainties stemming from the pandemic, which starkly exposed social and economic disparities, our mission to empower children and women persevered. I am thrilled to shine a spotlight on our impactful initiative, the "Kids Safe Harbor Program," a beacon of hope for the future of Ugandan children. In a landscape where educational opportunities are uneven, this program has become a sanctuary, nurturing and empowering over 500 children.

About the Kids Safe Harbor Program:

Our endeavor, rooted in the 2014 population census revealing educational gaps, focuses on rewriting the narratives of vulnerable children. Despite progress, 12.5% of children aged 6-12 remain out of school, and 8% of those under 18 are orphaned. The Kids Safe Harbor Program is our proactive response.

Our Impact and Approach:

Currently, the program stands as a haven for 516 children, each with dreams and potential waiting to be unearthed. Through our efforts:

- We ensure every child has access to quality education, bridging gaps in classrooms to leave no child behind.
- We recognize the symbiotic relationship between a child's progress and a mother's well-being, providing support to women for essentials such as food, clothing, and household items.
- Our approach transcends traditional boundaries, providing not just a space but a sanctuary where children find guidance, support, and necessary tools for navigating through life.

Critical Needs and Call to Action:

Today, we face an urgent challenge. The cost of food, a fundamental necessity, has surged, stretching our resources thin and posing a significant hurdle in our pursuit of providing holistic care. In the heart of the Luwero district, two remarkable sisters, Lataru Juliet (14) and Ekoni Phoebe (12), embody the resilience of the human spirit despite being born with visual and hearing impairments. Raised by a courageous single mother who strives to provide for her daughters after their father abandoned them due to their disabilities, the family's situation is poignant.

The Challenges:

The challenges of daily survival, compounded by the devastating impacts of the COVID-19 lockdown in Uganda, left them teetering on the brink of desperation. The vulnerability of this family came to light when a compassionate citizen reached out to PSM Charity through our YouTube channel, seeking support for Juliet, Phoebe, and their devoted mother, who were grappling with starvation.

PSM Charity's Response:

PSM Charity, driven by a mission to uplift and empower, promptly visited the family. We provided immediate relief in the form of food and essential supplies, ensuring their urgent needs were met and alleviating their immediate distress. Determined to explore every avenue to enhance the lives of Juliet and Phoebe, PSM Charity facilitated a medical consultation at Mengo Hospital.

In the communities we serve, young girls, some as tender as 12 years old, find themselves grappling with the abrupt end of their education due to early pregnancies. Often ostracized by their families and abandoned by those responsible, these young mothers seek refuge in makeshift shelters, facing the harrowing challenges of hunger, insecurity, and uncertainty about their futures. Without intervention, both mother and child are at risk of being marginalized, perpetuating a cycle of poverty and hardship.


Our Approach:

The Youthful Moms, Resilient Futures Program is crafted to be a sanctuary of hope and opportunity. We understand the pivotal role single mothers play in shaping their children's futures and believe that, with support, they can rise above their circumstances.

- Skill Development and Education: We aim to provide these young mothers with vocational training, equipping them with skills that enable self-reliance. From tailoring to agriculture, these skills can be their ticket to a sustainable livelihood.
- Health and Wellness: Ensuring the health and wellbeing of both mother and child is paramount. Access to healthcare, nutritional support, and counseling services will form a critical component of this program.
- Childcare Support: By establishing safe spaces for childcare, we enable these young mothers to pursue education and work opportunities without concern for their children's safety and wellbeing.
- Community Sensitization: Educating the community about the plight and potential of these young mothers can foster a more inclusive and supportive environment.

Our organization has successfully supported 260 vulnerable/orphan children, offering comprehensive assistance that goes beyond the basic necessities. Through your generous support, we've been able to provide:

Accommodation: Creating a safe and nurturing environment for these children to thrive.

Educational Materials: Equipping them with the tools for academic success, including books, pens, rulers, and more.

Menstrual Hygiene Kits: Ensuring the dignity and well-being of young girls with essential items like buckets, knickers, soap, sanitary towels, and more. Personal Hygiene and Home Necessities: Fostering overall health and comfort with items such as sponges, bathroom towels, shavers, petroleum jelly, bedding, padlocks and keys, flasks, and more.

Holiday Packages: Providing enriching experiences for all classes, making holidays a time of joy and exploration.



In 2019 to 2021, our organization successfully constructed 25 spring water wells in Nakisunga Sub- County, Mukono District, Uganda, benefiting over 25000 people with access to clean water. However, due to financial constraints from COVID-19 onwards, we have been unable to continue funding this crucial project. Your support is urgently needed to resume and sustain this initiative, ensuring communities have continued access to clean water. Join us in making a vital difference.



One impactful project that has significantly transformed the lives of youth and single mothers in our communities is our training program. Take, for instance, the inspiring story of Nantege Ruth from Kaliiti, Mende sub-county, Wakiso District. At just twelve years old, she faced immense challenges after becoming pregnant in P.6 and being disowned by her parents. However, she found a lifeline with us.

Through our fashion and designing training, Ruth not only learned valuable skills but gained the ability to support herself and her baby. She now aspires to pursue further studies next year, showcasing the transformative power of education and skills development.

This year, we've supported five individuals in similar situations, and with your help, we can extend this impact to reach thousands more. The prevalence of mental illness in Uganda is significant, affecting at least 7.4% of the population, as per recent WHO data. Despite its widespread impact, many individuals do not seek treatment due to poor insight, lack of awareness about available resources, and dissatisfaction with past services.

Stigmatization further isolates those with mental health problems, perpetuating misconceptions about their condition. PSM Charity addresses this issue, especially among youth affected by drug and substance abuse. Our approach involves not only providing medical treatment but also social support, home visits, and fostering a sense of humanity.

While we currently assist 10% of our patients, additional funds will enable us to extend our vital services to more vulnerable individuals who have not yet been reached.


