Key Activities

Project Implementation Timeline

- 1.Month 1-2 | Community outreach and participant recruitment. Prepare educational materials and secure facilitators and venues.
- 2.Month 3-4 | Conduct educational workshops and initiate personalized nutritional counseling sessions.
- 3.Month 5-6 | Distribute support materials and officially launch peer support groups. Monitor and evaluate the program's impact.

Expected Outcomes

- 1.Increased Knowledge | 500 mothers will gain a deeper understanding of breastfeeding and maternal nutrition.
- 2.Behavioral Change | 70% of mothers will adopt improved breastfeeding techniques and dietary habits.
- 3.Community Building | Establish at least five active peer support groups, ensuring long-term sustainability and peer education.
- 4.Improved Health | Reduced cases of malnutrition and illness among infants due to enhanced maternal practices.

Monitoring and Evaluation

The success of the Mother's Milk Miracle project will be measured through:

- 1.Pre- and Post-Program Surveys | Assess knowledge gained and changes in practices.
- 2. Nutritional Assessments | Track improvements in maternal and infant health indicators.
- 3. Support Group Feedback | Regular feedback sessions to evaluate the impact and adapt as needed.

Sustainability Plan
